The Department of Homeland Security awards C-TPAT Certification to Forward Logistics Group

Forward Logistics Group (FLG) is proud to announce formal certification as a participant in the Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (C-TPAT) program, issued by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Customs and Border Protection.

In October of 2003, FLG voluntarily submitted an in-depth application and a Supply Chain Security Profile to apply for C-TPAT certification. This profile included a comprehensive review of the company's security policies, including facilities and physical security, theft prevention, shipping and receiving controls, Information Security controls, and internal controls. Further examination looked into FLG's security procedures for internal personnel, as well as requirements in place for using outside Service Providers.

Forward Logistics is required to develop and maintain a complete and detailed security plan, which must be made available for Customs to review upon request at any time. Also, as part of FLG's ongoing C-TPAT commitment, a self-policing plan will be developed in order to review security procedures on a regular basis.

Forward Logistics is committed to providing global supply chain security measures as a C-TPAT participant and will be eligible to participate in anti-terrorism training seminars, sharing of information and best practices from the CBP.
